About the Project

Snapshot is a 6 day co-operational project, offered through the European Youth Education and Meeting Center in Weimar, the Buchenwald and Mittelbau-Dora Memorial Foundation and the Klassik Foundation Weimar. This is reflected in the program's contents: the classical time of Goethe and Schiller, the history of Bauhaus (with van de Velde), the crimes of National Socialism, and what that all has to do with us today.

The central theme of the project revolves around the question of »mensbeeld«: What forms humanity? What rights do humans have? What does this mean for human coexistence? For this purpose, we are looking at the past and discussing how we shape our lives today as well as how the future should look. Last but not least, it's about ourselves.

In order to find answers, we work together in small seminar groups each with about 20 people. We work with creative methods and visit different places of remembrance in Weimar as well as the Buchenwald memorial. Since there is not enough time to visit all museums, on Tuesday you can choose between the central theme of Weimar Classicism or classical Modernity (van de Velde and Bauhaus). An important aspect is the discussion about how we value what we see and learn and what it means for us. In the process, we mix the groups continually in order to make a more intensive exchange possible. In order to realize these themes and to end the week, we develop small presentations in artistic workshops (such as film, theater and art).

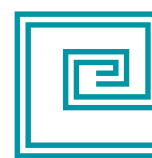

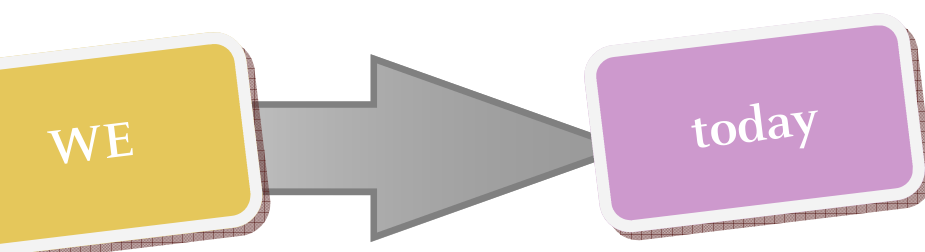
